**Footnotes**

IT'S NOT UNUSUAL chased off the rail, came out into the stretch, gained the advantage under some hand urging past midstretch and drew clear under hold late. NO STADIUM stalked off the rail, bid between horses on the backstretch then stalked again, re-bid between foes on the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, inched away in midstretch, could not match the winner in the final sixteenth but held second. UNCLE GREG stalked off the rail bid three deep on the backstretch then tracked outside, bid again three wide on the second turn and into the stretch, was between horses in midstretch and edged a rival for the show. CASA O angled in and settled inside, came out into the stretch and again nearing midstretch and put in a late bid at a minor award. WARREN'S GRIDLOCK sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, responded when rivals loomed on the backstretch and inched away again, battled inside on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong.
