LA NEZ stalked the pace off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, took the advantage outside foes nearing midstretch, inched away under urging and held. PERFECT VINTAGE had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and in the stretch and gamely edged rivals for the place. U R ALL THAT I AM stalked the pace a bit off the rail, lacked room behind rivals in upper stretch, came out off heels in midstretch and finished well between foes late. MS. G. I. JANE a bit slow to begin, settled just off the rail, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and was edged for a minor award three deep on the line. I CAN HEAR chased a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and could not summon the needed late kick. U TURN ME CRAZY dueled outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, battled between horses in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. MONEY LOVER off a bit slowly and steadied in the early stages, chased outside a rival, swung out four wide into the stretch and did not rally. RUINATION broke out a bit, stalked outside a rival then off the rail on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and weakened.
