SHORT MEMO broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail, went outside a rival leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch, closed gamely to gain the lead approaching the sixteenth marker and won clear under some urging. CRISPY COREY stalked three deep on the backstretch and into the turn, bid alongside a rival leaving the turn, took a short advantage in the stretch, was not a match for the winner in the final sixteenth but held second. HITTHEROADRUNNING chased off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and just missed the place. THE UNUSUAL ONE stalked inside, awaited room into the stretch, tried to go through inside in midstretch but steadied in tight along the rail, got through late and was edged for a minor award. LE' HEAT settled a bit off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came out in the stretch and split horses at the wire. EMERALD ASSETS stalked between horses on the backstretch and outside a rival on the turn and weakened in the stretch. FRANCONI angled in and saved ground chasing the pace to the stretch and did not rally. URBAN HUNTER sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail then dueled inside on the turn, came slightly off the fence in the stretch, fought back past midstretch, was between foes in deep stretch and weakened late. PHARO'S GOLD chased outside then alongside a rival, dropped back on the turn and gave way.
