SOUL CANDY a bit slow into stride, angled in and settled just off the rail, went inside a rival on the second turn, came out into the stretch and rallied under some urging and good handling to gain the lead in deep stretch then proved best. UNUSUAL SUSPECT stalked inside then split horses on the backstretch, continued outside a rival approaching the second turn, went between foes again on that turn, waited briefly into the stretch, came out off heels in deep stretch and edged ENRICHED late for the place. ENRICHED stalked inside then a bit off the rail, bid alongside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, took the lead leaving that turn, inched away in the stretch, held on well to deep stretch, could not match the winner late and just lost second. CAYAMBE pulled a bit and stalked off the rail, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. MOBILIZED saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response in the final furlong. LODI RED sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, dueled on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the stretch. LOW GEAR POWER three deep on the first turn, chased outside or off the rail, came out into the stretch and did not rally. MY BOY WALSH between horses early, chased outside a rival then three deep midway on the backstretch, continued three wide into the second turn and off the rail into the stretch and weakened.
