**Footnotes**

PURSE LUVA chased five wide then outside a rival on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, gained the advantage under left handed urging three wide in midstretch, drifted in and won clear. GOOD BROTHER stalked the pace inside, waited off heels into the turn and fell back some, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and picked up the place late. WORKING CAPITAL had speed between foes then dueled inside a rival, fought back on the turn and a bit off the rail in the stretch and held third. PRIDE OF WILSHIRE pulled his way along to stalk the pace inside then just off the fence on the turn, lacked room off heels in midstretch but could not summon the necessary late kick. CAT CALLOWAY chased between horses then fell back toward the inside into the turn, saved ground on the bend, swung out into the stretch and improved position. P FORTY WARHAWK bumped at the start, chased between horses then outside, went three deep on the turn and into the stretch and did not rally. MINISTERS POWER chased between rivals, was shuffled back some a half mile out, went four wide on the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed response. BOSTON BAKED BEAN bumped between horses and squeezed back at the start, settled a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn, split horses past midstretch and was not a factor. MINISTER MACHINE had speed outside rivals then dueled alongside a foe, put a head in front on the turn, was between horses in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. RITZVILLE chased between foes then off the rail, angled inward in the stretch and weakened.
