BRIECAT came out and bumped a rival early then sped to the lead a bit off the rail, angled in and set the pace along the inside, responded when challenged past midstretch and held on gamely under urging. WESTWOOD PRIDE bumped by the winner early, stalked outside a rival then a bit off the rail, bid alongside the winner past midstretch and continued willingly between foes late. TURNING TOP (IRE) was in a good position stalking the pace outside a rival to the stretch, came out in the drive and closed willingly three deep on the line. WYNNING RIDE squeezed in a bit tight early, angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came out some in the stretch and rallied between foes late. DISTINCTIVE (GB) in a bit tight after the start, angled in and was rank inside stalking the pace, saved ground throughout and could not offer the necessary late kick. PRINCESS TAYLOR (GB) also in a bit tight early, settled just off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, saved ground into the stretch, came out in the drive and finished with interest between foes late. BLUE MAIDEN (GB) squeezed a bit in the early running, chased outside a rival or a bit off the rail to the stretch and found her best stride late four wide on the wire. VALUE STREAM three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival, came out in upper stretch and did not rally.
