ELENA'S PRINCESS vied for the lead from the start, raced along the inside throughout and drew off in mid stretch while under mild encouragement. HICKORY GRAY vied for the lead from the two path through the far turn, then gave way late and finished second best. NANA D pressed the pace from the two path through the far turn, then angled outward at the 1/4 pole and made a late bid. SUPER HEROINE was close up early, raced along the inside on the second turn, then lacked a late response. COAL VALLEY was slow early, raced along the inside on the far turn, then angled outward at the top of the stretch but lacked a rally. LOVELY AS EVER raced four wide on the second turn and was outrun to mid stretch, then passed tiring rivals. ED'S PRINCESS was close up early, raced three wide on the second turn, then faded in the lane. BI ROSE lacked speed, raced two wide on the far turn and showed little. THE COLOR RED was three wide on the far turn, then failed to menace and was outrun.
