EAST TO EDEN set the pace from the start, saved ground throughout and finished under urging. MYPRINCESSALLYSON was never far back, raced two wide on the turn, then angled to the outside in the stretch and closed willingly. AFTER THE APPLAUSE was close up from the start, raced three wide on the turn, then made a mild bid late. TAMARIND HALL pressed the pace from the two path through the turn, then weakened in the final yards. GOTTAHOPE was close up and inside on the turn, then drifted outward but was sustained and lacked then needed late rally. LIL PRECIOUS stalked the early pace, raced two wide on the turn, then gave way late. ROBYNTHEKOOP was close up early, raced inside on the turn, then angled outward and faded late. PATTON'S PASSION raced inside through the turn, was outrun to mid stretch then passed the tired ones. KITTY'S DREAM lacked speed, raced two wide on the turn and failed to menace. MISS FLEETFOOT was carried wide on the turn, then tired late and was outrun.
