TOO MUCH ATTITUDE stalked the pace from the three path through the turn, then rallied late from the outside and was up in the final strides. SIS DRAPER pressed the pace from the two path through the turn, reached contention in mid stretch the was outfinished at the wire. BEST CAMPER set the pace from the start, saved ground through the turn then was headed late and gave way. GUTTERBALL MARY was never far back, raced two wide on the turn, then lacked a rally in the stretch. DESK REFERENCE was close up and inside on the turn while racing evenly. CHROME COINS pressed the pace from the inside through the turn then weakened. SHE'S A VIXEN raced along the inside on the turn and failed to menace. SODA POP JUSTICE raced two wide on the turn and was not a threat. BATTLE BAR stumbled at the start then trailed the field.
