Footnotes

BOOM DE YA DA stalked the early leader two wide, took over entering the stretch and held after a prolonged drive. CONFLICTING REPORT was caught wide while unhurried around the first turn, moved three wide to vie nearing the stretch but couldn't get by the winner. NO INFLATION was caught in tight along the inside around the first turn and for most of the backstretch, swung out entering the stretch and came up empty. WEGGIE was unhurried early, swung wide into the stretch and finished with good energy. DRAYTON HALL was slow early then made up some ground. JAKE'S MISSION was outrun inside. ELДАРION broke sharply to make the pace along the inside to the stretch then tired. DANCE WITH BULL had position outside into the far turn then tired. QUICK CHANGE trailed.
