**Footnotes**

DEW DETIME set the pace while saving ground then just lasted while under urging. TWO MINUTE HEIST was slow early, raced two wide on the turn, then angled outward and closed willingly. TOMORROWS DOUBLE pressed the pace from the two path through the turn then weakened. MORTOS SPEEDMAN was close up and three wide on the turn, then lacked a late response. J T'S BAD BOY was void of early speed, raced two wide on the turn then rallied mildly in the stretch. ROYAL AUSTIN was two wide on the turn and not a threat. PASTOR CASAR was close up early, raced inside on the turn then faded in the stretch. FOXY CLOSE UP failed to menace. GRAND LOVER broke in the air, then raced three wide on the turn and weakened thereafter. PHOTO OPPORTUNITY showed good early speed, raced two wide on the turn then faltered. WEEDWHIPPER lacked speed then showed little. MORE THAN FLASHY trailed the field.
