ALINA'S LAD stalked the pace from the three path through the second turn, then reached contention in mid stretch and drew off while under urging. FORT DENMARK was unhurried early, raced along the three path on the far turn, then rallied in the stretch and was up for place. LIGHTS OUT LIDGE was slow early, raced two wide on the last turn, then closed ground willingly. COME ON OVER set the pace from the start, was under pressure early, raced along the inside and drew off on the second turn, then was headed in mid stretch and gave way. MONTY CAT was close up early, dropped back, raced along the inside on the second turn then angled outward and passed the tired ones. FLYBIRD pressed the early pace, raced two wide on the far turn, then weakened in the stretch. ROMANS REWARD stalked the pace from the two path through the second turn, then faltered late. MEDAGLIA'S IMAGE was close up early, raced inside on the last turn then tired and was outrun.
