STAR OF MAGIC set the pace from the start, held a clear lead while saving ground through the far turn, then was ridden out to the wire. SOCIO D'ORO was unhurried early, raced along the inside on the last turn then angled outward and made a late bid and held place. JACKSON'S RHYTHM pressed the pace from along the inside through the second turn, then lacked a late response. STRONGEST was void of early speed, raced three wide on the last turn, then made a mild bid late. WILDLEE CERTAIN was close up early, raced two wide on the far turn then lacked a rally late. MARKET TIDE raced along the inside on the second turn and failed to menace. MISTER POMEROY lacked speed, raced along the two path on the far turn and trailed throughout.
