Footnotes

INFLATETABILITY vied for the early lead from along the inside, dropped back on the turn, then angled to the outside in the stretch and came again while under steady urging. DEEPLY SMITTEN vied for the early lead from the three path, gained command on the turn with a clear lead, then began to tire in mid stretch and was outfinished. FRECKLESANCURLS saved ground and raced evenly. MICROGOLD pressed the pace into the turn from the two path, then failed to sustain that bid. MANE STREET BANK raced along the inside on the turn and failed to menace. ALMOST A MEMORY saved ground and was not a factor. LITTLE BIG BIG was void of early speed, raced along the inside on the turn and passed tiring rivals. PENDALIN raced along the inside, then drifted out at the 3/8 pole to be three wide on the turn showing little speed. AARONESS showed no speed, was four wide on the turn and outdistanced in the stretch.
