Footnotes

GHOSTWRITER set the pace from the start, saved ground through the turn, and finished under urging. NOIFSWHATSORBUTS pressed the pace while saving ground through the turn, then made a mild bid and was no match for the winner. WINONEFORTHEZIPPER was close up along the backstretch, raced three wide on the turn, then made a late bid. FOOTWEDGE pressed the pace from the two path through the turn, then weakened in the drive. SAINTLY ZEALOUS was slow early, saved ground on the turn, then made a mild bid in the stretch. WITTY KID was void of early speed, saved ground on the turn and was not a threat. KINNIKONICK pressed the early pace, raced two wide on the turn, then faltered in the stretch. MAX AGAIN was close up early, raced three wide on the turn, then was through after a half. SLAMMIN BEAUTIFUL showed brief speed, raced along the two path on the turn, then tired and was outrun.
