FINANCIAL MISSION stalked the pace from the start, raced along the three path on the turn, then drew clear in the stretch and finished under left handed encouragement. COUNTRY RISK was unhurried early, raced along the inside on the turn then moved outward in mid stretch and made a late bid. IN HIGH REGARDS was also unhurried early, raced three wide on the turn, then made a mild bid late. STONELESS vied for the lead from along the inside through the turn, then gave way in the drive. ANOTHER PEPPI was slow early, saved ground on the turn, then made a mild bid in the lane. DON'S LEGEND vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, then weakened in the stretch. GIVING THANKS was close up early, raced along the three path on the turn, then faded in the drive. YES I'M SURE raced three wide on the turn and was through after a half. COOLATTIN lacked speed, raced four wide on the turn and was outrun.
