Footnotes

FOREVER TANGO raced three wide with the early pace, moved clear before six furlongs, responded when challenged into the final furlong and drew out again through late stretch. COLORMINE BLUE was in tight at the break then was unhurried, was caught five wide while moving into the stretch, vied outside the winner into the final furlong then weakened. DELIGHTFUL DANA was in tight at the break then was caught in tight between rivals nearing the end of the backstretch, raced three wide between rivals into the stretch, angled to the inside and flattened out. SUPREME MISS had position, was caught four wide between rivals into the stretch then weakened. SHARIK was slow to settle, raced wide into the stretch and passed tired ones. POLISH DANCE dueled two wide inside the winner to the stretch then tired. MY LADY A. P. was in tight at the break then was outrun. NORTHERN BERKSHIRE stayed close along the rail to the stretch then stopped.
