SMALLTOWNMAN was rated while racing well out from the inside then closed outside through the lane and ran clear late. PAYTON'S VICTORY was unhurried inside, came out entering the far turn while moving, vied four wide into the stretch, dueled on even terms for command into deep stretch but couldn't contain the winner. BLACK CHEVRON settle early, came out three wide for room nearing the lane, dueled inside to late stretch then weakened. NOAH'S HARVEST had early position three wide, took over two wide on the final turn then weakened. WILD AND WILEY lagged then passed tired ones. HELPING HAND set the early pace inside then tired. TAR BEACH pressed two wide to the far turn then stopped.
