LOVE TREASURES was slow early, raced two wide on the turn, then angled outward and closed fast drawing clear under urging. ELEGANT CAD was never far back, raced four wide on the turn, then made a late bid to be second best. LAUGHING MOON pressed the pace from the three path through the turn, contended late then weakened then broke down and fell at the 7 1/2 pole and was euthanized. UNSUAL MANNER vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, entered into a long drive then gave way late. NOW AND ZEN raced three wide on the turn and lacked a rally. PHOR PHILIPPE was close up early, raced two wide on the turn, then faded late. BLENIEM raced three wide on the turn and failed to menace. SYLVIA'S FORTE vied for the lead from the inside to the turn, then faltered in the drive and fell over the stricken horse pulling up after the race. BIG CHAMP vied for the lead from the inside, was through early and outrun.
