PLEDGE OF TRUTH settled, was sent up three wide on the turn, opened a short lead in early stretch and held stubbornly. FREESTYLER came in leaving the gate and caused bumping, took over from the outside just before a quarter, stayed out from the rail around the turn and continued with good courage once displaced. TENTHSTREET was slow early, made a four wide run around the turn but couldn't gain the lane. HOLY SNIP was bumped at the break, trailed early then outfinished tired ones. CRUISE DIRECTOR broke slowly, came out two wide on the turn and failed to menace. PROVIDENTIAL BID was bumped at the break gained position two wide then tired in the lane. LIBERTY CITY broke sharply, made the early pace, stayed inside and tired in the lane.
