THINKING OUT LOUD raced two wide with the pace and edged clear through the final furlong. THREE IN THE BAG raced inside the winner and gave way grudgingly. DEVIL APPROVED IT settled, advanced between horses on the final turn, came out for room in early stretch then gained late. BRUSH ON BY was unhurried while racing out from the rail then made a belated run between horses. BLENIEM settle in good position, came out side on the final turn then flattened out. TORI LIGHT was wide and outrun. HERMAN'S SOLDIER made a mild run inside on the final turn then flattened out. OUT IN THE OPEN came out wide while making a mild run on the final turn then stopped in the lane and was eased up late.
