COALTOWN LEGEND stayed out from the rail while unhurried, vied outside into the final furlong then bore out under left hand whip. FRENCH MOON wasn't far back while racing well out from the rail then weakened while second best. MR. REAL DEAL showed speed while out from the rail, edged clear midway on the turn then tired. LOVE YOU TOO wasn't far back early, stayed out from the rail and tired. WHO'S BLUFFING showed speed inside to the stretch then tired. CASE NOTES showed speed outside then tired. SIR GALAHAD was outrun after a slow break. RIGHT FLANKER trailed.
