CHANGING VISTA was never far back, raced three wide on the turn then reached contention late and prevailed at the wire. STELLSIE set the pace with a clear lead, saved ground through the turn, then was headed late and missed at the wire. SEASIDE FORTUNE pressed the pace from the two path through the turn, then weakened in mid stretch. IRISH GARDEN prompted the pace from the two path through the turn, then lacked a late response. FIRE AND FORGET was unhurried early, raced two wide on the turn, then made a mild bid late. TOWER CLOSE was slow early, raced along the inside on the turn and failed to menace. NEWPORT LULU pressed the early pace, saved ground on the turn, then faded in the stretch. GINNYGIN showed early speed, raced along the inside on the turn, then was through after a half.
