S W AIDAN vied for the lead the drew off early, raced along the inside throughout, was headed late and just lasted. H W GOODIE was unhurried early, raced two wide on the second turn, then reached contention in the stretch and just missed at the wire. REDLIGHTGREENLIGHT was close up early, raced inside through the second turn, then lacked a late response. UNCEASING vied for the early lead then dropped back, pressed the leader from the three path on the far turn before fading late. TRUMATCH stalked the early pace, raced four wide on the far turn, then failed to sustain a bid. STORM BY raced two wide on the second turn, then failed to menace. EXTRA HONOR was close up early, raced along the inside on the last turn, then faltered in the stretch. MR TALC saved ground but trailed throughout.
