SPIKEAVELLIAN began a run along the rail into the far turn, swung out entering the stretch and drove clear. EL CHILE DOG lagged early, came wide into the stretch and finished with good energy outside. WEST LIDO stayed out from the rail around the final turn, angled to the rail for the drive and gained mildly. ANGELIC AURA stayed well out from the inside and lacked a strong closing. MAKUTUS stayed out from the rail while making the way for about a mile then weakened. ROBYN CHIEF was unhurried then was caught in tight between horses through late stretch. MISSING BLUE made up some ground inside. MOUNT WEATHER made a mild run three wide on the final turn but failed to sustain. GLORIOUS SUNRISE stopped inside.
