DISTORTED APPEAL cleared soon after the break then was rated out from the rail, was asked into the far turn, was roused in early stretch and held on. MARKET TIDE was unhurried while caught wide around the first turn, remained well out from the rail while moving outside horses down the backstretch and around the final turn then made up ground through late stretch. VANDER GELDER was content to lag while kept outside, circled the final turn and finished willingly outside. SHADE OF ALLEY stayed well out from the rail while chasing the winner but lacked the needed response. NAIF wasn't far back while along the rail but failed to respond. COPPER TIGER settled between horses, raced two wide around the final turn and continued evenly. QUARTERBACK SNEAK wasn't far back between horses early and was finished after a half. BRASS NOTE had early position three wide, remained within distance into the far turn then stopped. BIG BUDGET was lacked speed, raced wide around the final turn and failed to menace. BUH BUH BUH BENNY stopped inside.
