Footnotes

NAIF was rated outside early, moved to the fore from between horses nearing the end of the backstretch, drew out before three quarters then widened under intermittent urging. BUBBLE GUM SHRIMP was slow early, made a run outside rivals to loom a threat outside the winner into the far turn then flattened out. GELT was slow early, angled to the inside on the final turn then tired. DOCTOR DANGER was caught in tight between horses on the backstretch and into the far turn then tired. MY SEBY fell far back early then passed tired ones. LOCOMOTION LOUIE was caught in tight along the rail on the backstretch then stopped. PAXON was caught in tight on the backstretch then stopped. BAYOU COWBOY briefly showed speed. CREO pressed the pace along the inside to the end of the backstretch then stopped. RIMFIRE made the early pace two wide then stopped and was eased up.
