**Footnotes**

NICETOSEEEY'AGAIN was unhurried inside, was in tight between rivals nearing the lane, split horses to gain command in midstretch and edged clear. GHOSTS AND LEGENDS was unhurried, stayed well out from the rail while moving on the final turn then finished gamely outside. BORN TO CUS settled, rallied well out from the rail around the final turn, took over in early stretch and gave way through the final sixteenth. MR. HENRY TWO U was slow to settle, stayed close to the rail around the final turn and found best stride too late. YEP was slow to settle, raced two wide into the stretch then angled out between horses and gained mildly. ZIO TONY held a short lead two wide into the far turn, moved clear approaching the lane then weakened. ZOARES LAND raced two wide in an even effort. THREE QUARTER TOUT tired inside. THIS BULLS BACK was caught in tight along the rail in early stretch. BOXER SHORTS pressed inside the early leader into the far turn then stopped in the lane.
