PROSECUTOR vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, then dueled in the stretch and drew off late. SIMON'S GIRL stumbled badly at the start, then raced close up and along the inside through the turn, angled outward in the stretch and found her best stride late to be second best. OUR MAMA DEAR was never far back, raced four wide on the turn, then made a late closing effort. VALLEY OF QUEENS vied for the lead from along the inside through the turn, was engaged in a long drive then gave way late. SHAMROCK'S TUNE was slow to start, raced two wide on the turn then rallied mildly in the lane. CATANGELIC pressed the pace early, raced two wide through the turn then weakened late. ROCK ON THELMA forced the early pace, raced three wide on the turn, then tired in the stretch. LUDUS MAGNUS showed brief speed, raced five wide on the turn and was through early.
