FIRST LADY GLENNA was never far back, raced along the four path on the last turn, then rallied late and was up in the final strides. DARK CONTINENT was close up and three wide on the far turn, then closed ground late and just missed. WINDY ANGEL pressed the pace from the start, raced two wide on the second turn, then weakened in the final yards. READ RICHIES NOTES stalked the pace early, gained command on the far turn while saving ground, then faded late. ASHBY LAND was void of early speed, raced two wide on the last turn, then found her best stride late. AMERICAN BREW lacked speed, raced inside on the second turn and showed little throughout. CRAFTY GEM set the pace from the start, was headed early, then faltered on the far turn. BANKER BAILOUT was through early, raced two wide on the last turn, then was outrun in the stretch.
