POINTEDLY TRUE stalked the pace from the two path through the turn, contended in mid stretch then drew off while under urging. NISTLE set the pace from the start, saved ground through the turn, then was headed late and gave way. TO BOLDLY GO was close up early, raced along the three path through the turn, then lacked a late response. TRUE GOOD'S was void of early speed, raced three wide through the turn, then made a mild bid late. CATANGELIC was slow early, raced along the inside on the turn and was not a threat. CAROL SNUCK IN raced two wide on the turn and failed to menace. PARS GO EFFIE GO lacked speed, raced two wide on the turn and showed little throughout. JOYCE RAY was close up early, raced inside on the turn, then was through after a half. LITTLE LION was fractious in the gate, then showed good early speed but faltered on the turn and was outrun.
