OUTLAW CHOCTAW set the pace from the start, saved ground, call obscured on the far turn, and led throughout, then finished under encouragement. KILLER DILLER was unhurried early, obscured call second turn, then rallied but was no match for the winner. LIDO KEY was close up early, obscured call on the second turn, then made a mild bid late. PROUD TIGER was slow early, obscured call on the far turn, then advanced steadily through the stretch. NO ORDINARY GUY was void of early speed, obscured call on the last turn, then rallied mildly in the lane. JETTIES BEACH was outrun early, obscured call on the far turn, then passed the tired ones. BEAVER CREEK was close up early, obscured call on the second turn, then faded late. ECHSTEIN VILLAGE was close up early, obscured call on the far turn, then faltered in the stretch. DINNERANDASHOW pressed the pace from the two path, obscured call last turn, then gave way late. VIAJERO stalked the pace from along the inside, obscured call on second turn, then flattened out in the drive.
