SCUBAI DUBAI showed speed from the outset, was clear before going a furlong, stayed inside and was under brisk urging through the lane. PRIVATE LAD was unhurried, came out three wide on the turn and outfinished the others for the place. LATIN COUNT wasn't far back early, raced two wide around the turn then weakened in the lane. UNIVERSE DRIVE stayed inside and lacked a strong closing. CARO MEL raced two wide and passed tired ones. JOY FROM PHOENIX was no factor. TOMORROWS DOUBLE stopped inside. H F WILD ALEX was outrun. SNORKEY was outrun. FOXWOOD'S HERO was outrun. RETURN OF THE LION showed speed to the stretch then stopped. CHEF SOUFLE stopped.
