JUICY LUCY pressed the pace from the two path through the turn, then drew off in the stretch under mild encouragement. NO IRONING SUNDAY was never far back, raced four wide through the turn, then rallied mildly in the lane. I. C. GOLD was close up early, raced three wide on the turn, then made a mild bid late. PARADISE CAFE stumbled at the start, then raced close up and inside through the turn but lacked a late response. ENDEARING CORREDOR set the pace from the start, saved ground through the turn, then faded in the drive. TOSSABOUQUET was void of early speed, raced two wide on the turn then showed little. NAUGHTY KITTY was three wide on the turn and failed to menace. BARRINGTON HILLS raced three wide on the turn and lacked speed. VELVET GARDEN was through after a half and outrun.
