THE COLOR RED stalked the pace from along the inside, angled outward at the 1/4 pole, contended late and prevailed. BREAK FAST TIFFANY was slow early, raced two wide on the second turn, rallied and just missed. VESPER was never far back, raced three wide on the far turn then made a late bid. PERFECT KRIS stalked the pace from the two path through the far turn, contended then weakened in the stretch. UNBRIDLED PEACE was void of early speed, raced four wide on the last turn then made a mild bid. BATTLE OF BRITAIN was close up early, raced three wide on the far turn and faded in the stretch. DEBRAELLA saved ground. GHOSTLY SPIRIT set the pace early, was headed on the turn and gave way. CORPORATE MISTRESS was close up early, raced three wide on the second turn, then fell in the stretch.
