Footnotes

WILLIES GRAND SLAM was never far back outside, was sent three wide to command midway on the turn, drew out in early stretch and widened under brisk urging. LAFETER EVER AFTER showed speed from the outset, pressed the pace two wide into the turn but weakened in the lane while second best. SANDAZAR was slow to settle, stayed well out from the inside and outfinished tired ones. QUANAH GOLD wasn't far back early, came out three wide on the turn then weakened. JUST HANG ON lagged early following a slow break and failed to menace. WISE THINKING was caught in a bit tight along the rail while behind the leaders entering the turn, angled out and stopped in the lane. BERTRANDO GRANDE moved to a short lead from the inside just before going a furlong, remained in command into the turn then stopped. NACHITO was outrun.
