**Footnotes**

BADGE OF QUALITY set the pace from the start, saved ground throughout and finished under urging. GREENBRIER was never far back, raced inside through the turn, then rallied mildly to be second best. SOUP AND SANDIE was slow early, raced four wide on the turn, then found his best stride late. MIDNIGHT RUSH stalked the pace from the two path through the turn, angled outward but lacked a late response. AFTERNOON GUY was close up early, raced inside through the turn then failed to sustain his bid. EBERLE pressed the pace from the start, raced two wide through the turn, then weakened in the stretch. NORTHERN STREAM prompted the pace from the two path through the turn, then faded in the stretch. CHARCOAL CITY lacked speed, raced four wide on the turn and showed little. STORM MUSICAL raced along the inside on the turn and failed to menace. BAYWIND MOON was close up early, raced two wide on the turn, then was through after a half.
