OUR HAE vied for the lead from the start, raced along the two path through the turn, dueled in the stretch and prevailed at the wire. SMALL GIANT was never far back, raced four wide through the turn, then rallied late and just missed. OMINOUS THOMAS vied for the lead from along the inside through the turn, entered into a long drive then gave way. OCHO CABALLERO was close up and two wide through the turn, then failed to sustain a bid. STOLEN PARCEL was never far back, raced three wide through the turn, then lacked a late response. BERNIE'S SURPRISE was slow early, raced three wide on the turn, then made a mild bid late. SEEKING THE CODE was void of early speed, raced along the inside on the turn then rallied mildly in the lane. LONDON EYE lacked speed, raced four wide on the turn and was not a factor. SILENT SIPHON pressed the pace from the three path through the turn then faded. INSENSITIVE raced along the inside on the turn, was through after a half and outrun.
