S W LAURIE was close up from the start, raced three wide on the last turn and reached contention then entered into a long drive and drew off late. BONITA ESTIGO was unhurried early, raced two wide on the last turn then angled outward and close ground late. SPRING OF MONEY vied for the lead early, raced along the inside through the 2nd turn, then weakened in the stretch. CROATIAN DIVA stumbled at the start, then pressed the pace from the two path into the last turn, then gave way in the stretch. CLIPPER FAN vied for the lead from along the inside through the last turn, then weakened late. TUDOR RULE was unhurried early, saved ground on the far turn then lacked a rally. NOBLE MISS was close up early, raced three wide on the far turn, then failed to sustain a bid. TEMPESTA TEMPO vied for the lead from the two path through the last turn, then faltered in the stretch. SANDRA LA BELLE lacked speed, saved ground on the far turn while trailing throughout.
