CHEROKEE ROMANCE was bumped at the break then was sent clear before going a quarter, stayed inside and tired. FIDDLERS AMIGO lagged then passed tired ones. FIDDLIN' VILLAIN tired. TURN TO THE U S A stayed close to the far turn then stopped. ALI'S QUIET fell far back.
