**Footnotes**

LION'S KNEE was never far back, raced along the two path then angled out on the last turn and drew off while under steady encouragement. MARINE HYMN pressed the early pace, reached contention on the backstretch then raced along the two path through the turn before giving way in the stretch. CRIMSON CHROME pressed the pace from the start, saved ground through the last turn, then lacked a late response. FIRST CHIP was void of early speed, saved ground through the second turn, then passed tiring rivals. JUST ASK DADDY set the pace but was headed early, then raced along the inside through the far turn and faltered thereafter. WITT'S ROAD was close up early, raced three wide on the last turn, then flattened out in the lane. ROYAL TRACE was through early, then eased in the stretch.
