GATOR BAY stalked the pace from the three path through the turn, then rallied and drew clear in the stretch while finishing under steady encouragement. MY ELUSIVE STAR was unhurried early, raced two wide through the turn, then closed willingly. ANDREW L was close up early, raced along the inside through the turn, then lacked a late response. RYAN'S GOLD set the pace from the start, raced ground through the turn, then faded late. COUNTER MOVE was slow early, raced two wide on the turn and was not a threat. B'CAUSE B'CAUSE pressed the early pace, raced three wide on the turn and faltered. RED BENGAL lacked speed, raced inside on the turn and showed little throughout. ACADEMY RUN pressed the early pace, raced two wide on the turn then tired in the lane. RAHVINE'S SONG was through early and flattened out on the turn.
