Footnotes

MENIFEE SIX was unhurried early, raced three wide on the far turn, then rallied late and drew off under urging. ASK OMMADON was slow early, raced three wide on the last turn, then gained command late but was outfinished. WINGO (IRE) raced in the second flight on the backstretch, was two wide on the last turn then lacked a rally. LONG ISLAND LOUIE vied for the lead from the two path into the second turn, then faded late. KNEB WORTH raced in the middle of the pack on the backstretch, was inside through the second turn then lacked a late response. PLYMOUTH BAY raced three wide on the second turn and failed to menace. GAS HOUSE was void of early speed, raced two wide on the last turn and was never a threat. HORN BROOK trailed to the far turn then showed little thereafter. PAPERS TO PROVE IT vied for the early lead, then drew off on the backstretch then was headed on the far turn and flattened out. SILVER SHADOW was close up early, raced along the inside on the far turn then pulled up and walked off.
