GREAT INVESTMENT was caught wide while unhurried around the first turn, rallied the four path around the final turn, took over approaching the lane, was clear soon after and held under urging. STRONGEST stayed out from the rail while in control for over six furlongs and continued with good courage once displaced. ONEINTHEDARK didn't break sharply then was sent up to press outside the early leader and finished with good courage. MORE REUBENS lagged inside early, came out four wide on the final turn while rallying and gained to the end. TIZ RELEVANT was sent up the inside after a half then flattened out in the lane. ECLIPTICALS T BIRD wasn't far back between horses on the backstretch, raced three wide around the final turn then tired. REDWOOD MAN had position along the rail, was in tight entering the far turn, came out two wide then stopped and was eased up late. JABULANI was caught in tight early on the backstretch then stopped and was eased up late.
