Footnotes

INCENDIO stalked two wide to the stretch then drew off under a hand ride. ALLTHEWAYYEAH angled out nearing the end of the backstretch, vied three wide nearing the stretch then flattened out. RAIL ROADIE took command at once, stayed close to the inside and weakened. RED RIVER TOCCET raced wide around the turn and tired. FASTEST JAMES lagged early, came out on the turn while making a mild run but flattened out. MAGGIES DINER had early position between horses, angled to the rail on the turn then stopped and was eased up late.
