MISSION GAP stayed out from the rail once clear before a quarter and was under mild urging. CITIZEN KAT settled inside then rallied through the final quarter. PARTY NIGHT advanced wide around the first turn, moved closer on the outside before a half then weakened. FOUR SHORE stayed well out from the rail while unhurried, raced wide into the stretch and gained mildly. MY DREAM CATCHER stayed out from the rail while not far back to the far turn then tired. MAJI MOTO moved up between horses to press before a half, angled to the rail on the final turn and tired. TWO TAVERNS was unwilling to load then was outrun after a slow break. TURN TO THE KING tired between horses. HORSESHOE LAKE was outrun inside.
