**Footnotes**

WRIGHTGOODLION stalked the pace from the three path through the turn, then rallied late and was up in the final strides. OSCAR THE MAYOR pressed the pace from the two path on the turn, gained command in the stretch then was outfinished. PERSONAL SHOPPER was close up and along the inside through the turn while racing evenly throughout. HIGH FAVOR was never far back, raced four wide on the turn, then lacked a late rally. DELIVERY MAN was four wide through the turn, then made a mild bid late. NEW YORK STYLE was close up and two wide on the turn and raced evenly throughout. ALYS UPPERCUT set the early pace, saved ground on the turn, then faded in the drive. WESTERN KAZ showed brief speed, raced three wide on the turn, then faltered in the lane. KING LEOPOLD raced along the inside through the turn and was not a threat. MASHARKA lacked speed, raced four wide on the turn, then passed the tired ones. JO JO THE GREAT was close up early, raced four wide on the turn and flattened out thereafter. SADDLE CREEK was pinched back at the 3/4 pole, then raced three wide through the turn and was outrun.
