Footnotes

MAD BULLET set the pace from the start, saved ground throughout and finished under mild encouragement. MORT ROBBINS was never far back, raced three wide on the far turn, rallied mildly but was no match for the winner. ASTUTEST pressed the pace while saving ground on the last turn, then weakened in the drive. PERPLEXED was slow early, raced three wide on the far turn, then made a mild bid late. DARWIN HILL was close up early, raced three wide on the second turn, then lacked a late response. RADETSKY SALUTE was four wide on the last turn and failed to menace. WORKZONE pressed the pace from the two path through the far turn then faded. REDINGS MILL lacked speed and showed little. MOUNT BREVETOR pressed the early pace, raced two wide on the second turn, then faltered in the lane. IT'S MCGEE trailed the field.
