CORTADO set the pace soon after the start, saved ground and led throughout, then finished under urging. CORUNDUM pressed the pace from along the inside through the turn, then was no match for the winner. LEFT FOOT SLEWIE was close up early, raced two wide on the turn, then lacked a late response. I C U DAN showed good early speed, raced two wide on the turn and lacked a rally. LVIV was close up early, raced three wide on the turn, then made a mild bid late. STEINBRENNER had good early speed, raced inside on the turn, then faltered late. EASY ARGUMENT stalked the pace early, raced two wide on the turn, then tired in the stretch. HEY CHARLIE lacked speed, raced two wide on the turn and showed little. SPASOJE also lacked any speed, raced along the inside on the turn and was outrun.
