PONZI SCHEME stalked the pace from the three path, reached contention on the last turn, then drew clear in the stretch while under urging. FOREIGN ARGUMENT pressed the pace from the two path through the second turn, then was no match for the winner in the lane. SAVATRON was slow early, raced four wide on the last turn, then closed ground willingly from the outside, then lost rider at the 6 1/2 pole after the raced and was vanned off. FREE FIRE ZONE was void of early speed, raced three wide on the second turn, then showed little throughout. SENOR RUTLEDGE saved ground but failed to menace. SUMMITING pressed the pace from the two path, reached contention early, then faltered in the drive. A KISS IN THE PARK set the pace with a clear lead, was headed on the backstretch, then flattened out late.
